PENN TOWNSHIP 2024 REORGANIZATION MINUTES

January 2, 2024

The Penn Township Board of Supervisors held their Year 2024 Re-organization meeting on Tuesday, January 2, 2024 at the Municipal Building, 228 Clifford Road, Selinsgrove, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.

Present Included: Supervisors: Ross Smoker, Isaac Ramer Jr. and Mark Strawser, Solicitor, Jim Bathgate, and Manager, Julie Hartley

Public Present: Bill Kline, William Moyer, Jon Payne, Pete DeWire, Chad Brandt, Kyle Somers and Jeff Turner.

<u>Temporary Chairman</u> – On motion by Isaac Ramer Jr., second by Mark Strawser and Board acclamation to appoint Jim Bathgate as Temporary Chairman. Temporary Chairman Jim Bathgate called the 1.2.24 Supervisor's Reorganizational Meeting to order at 5:30 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Temporary Secretary</u> – On motion by Ross Smoker, second by Isaac Ramer Jr. and Board acclamation to appoint Julie Hartley as Temporary Secretary.

Appointment of Chairman

Temporary Chairman Jim Bathgate called for Chairman of the Board of Supervisors nominations. **Motion** made by Ross Smoker to nominate Isaac Ramer Jr. for Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, second by Mark Strawser and acclamation of Board.

Appointment of Vice-Chairman

Chairman Ramer called for Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors nominations. **Motion was made by** Ross Smoker to nominate Mark Strawser for Vice-Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, second by Isaac Ramer Jr. and acclamation of Board.

Resolution to Allow Working Supervisors — On motion by Ross Smoker, second by Mark Strawser to allow working Supervisors with Isaac Ramer Jr. voting no. Mark Strawser initially abstained from action because of a conflict of interest as he is a current employee of the Township but to break the tie he voted yes. Motion carried 2-1.

Manager Salary Rate – On motion by Isaac Ramer Jr., seconded by Mark Strawser and acclamation of Board to increase the salary of Julie Hartley by \$1,040 from \$54,017.60 to \$55,057.60.

<u>Manager Bond</u> – On motion by Isaac Ramer Jr., seconded by Mark Strawser and acclamation of Board to have the manager's bond remain at \$500,000.

<u>Vacancy Board</u> - On motion by Ross Smoker, second by Mark Strawser and acclamation of Board to reappoint William Kline for the Vacancy Board.

<u>Fee Schedule for 2024</u> – On motion by Isaac Ramer Jr., second by Ross Smoker and acclamation of Board the compost fees be changed for resident businesses from \$100 per year to \$1,000 per year and a one-time dump permit fee of \$50 be allowed to be purchased by non-resident businesses that are hauling from a Penn Township resident's property to the compost.

On motion by Ross Smoker, second by Mark Strawser, and acclamation of the Board that all 2024 fees are according to the fee schedule found in the minutes. (found on last pages)

<u>Executive Session</u> – Jim Bathgate announced that an executive session was held before the meeting from 5:00 pm to 5:30 pm to discuss legal issues with no action taken.

<u>Public Comment</u> – Jon Payne questioned the compost rate change for resident businesses and why the one dump fee and Isaac Ramer Jr. explained that the one dump fee for non-resident businesses should help the residents who hire outside contractors to still have access to the compost site. Jon Payne also questioned why the Board is now allowing working Supervisors. Ross Smoker answered that he was aware of prior issues but most that most Townships have working Supervisors without incident. Bill Moyer commented on the working Supervisor resolution also noting that the Township has a manager now. Chad Brandt asked the Board if the resident businesses must have business addresses within the Township and the Board answered that the business address must be within Penn Township.

Reorganization Adjournment – On motion by Ross Smoker, second by Isaac Ramer Jr., and acclamation of Board the reorganizational portion of the meeting was adjourned at 5:55 pm.

<u>December 20, 2023 Minutes</u> - On motion by Isaac Ramer Jr., second by Ross Smoker with Mark Strawser abstaining the 12.20.23 Supervisor Workshop Minutes were approved.

Persons Present to be Heard – Jeff Turner and Kyle Somers from Youth Football and Little League addressed the Board about the East Snyder's Park policy of closing at dusk. They noted that if the Youth Football makes it to the playoffs they cannot practice because of the lack of daylight without lighting. They are looking for a policy change to allow limited approved use of the park after dusk. Isaac Ramer Jr. who stated he is for opportunities for the youth but activities in the park after dusk would open up the Township to liabilities and lighting could disturb the neighboring residential properties. Jeff Turner said that Selinsgrove High School donated lights to the Little League but they have no funds to have an engineer design the layout at this time and wondered if Little League should pursue the field lighting project. The Board suggested that Little League and Youth Football meet with the East Snyder Regional Recreation Association and the Planning Commission to work out details with them so they can make recommendations to the Board.
