<u>Solar Zoning Ordinance Amendment</u> – Discussion was held regarding amendments to the Principal Solar Energy Systems and after discussion the following items were added to the recommended changes:

- 1) Add in section A (15) Permit Requirements:
 - c. An Emergency Contingency Plan shall be submitted.
 - d. Proof of Liability Insurance by the Contractor.
 - e. Provide a Leeching Study
- 2) Section A (1): Change to PSES shall be permitted by conditional use in the HC, I, RR and AC. AC subject to section 411.5 (B)
- 3) Add definition, Occupied Structure Any building used for business or a structure designed to allow overnight accommodations.
- 4) Remove B 2 c "The minimum side and rear yards specified above may be waived in the case of adjoining tracts of land within a single PSES, with landowner's mutual consent."
- 5) Remove B 11 "Not more than forty (40%) of class one or class two soils on any lot shall be devoted to PSES or its related equipment."
