## ORDINANCE NO. 1998 - <u>-1</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING SUPERVISOR PAY AT \$1,875 PER YEAR, PAYABLE QUARTERLY, FOR SUPERVISORS TAKING OFFICE ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 1998.

WHEREAS, Section 606 of the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. §65606) sets forth guidelines for the compensation to be paid Supervisors of Townships of the Second Class for the performance of their duties under the said Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 606 provides that Supervisors of Townships having a population of not more than 4,999 persons as of the last official census figures shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875 annually, such compensation to be paid monthly or quarterly, and established by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the population of Penn Township as of the official 1990 U.S. Census figures is 3,208 persons.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted as follows:

1. Each supervisor of Penn Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, elected or appointed to office on or after March 1, 1998, shall receive compensation as a Supervisor in the

annual amount of \$1,875.00.

2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly installments.

3. In the event that a supervisor shall begin or end office within a month, pay for

that month shall be prorated in proportion to the number of days of that month that the

supervisor held office.

4. This ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.
