

ORDINANCE NO. 2003 - ____

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96-1, PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG CERTAIN ROADS AND STREETS DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Penn Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 6 (a) of Article I of Township Ordinance No. 96-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Snow emergency parking restrictions.

(a) During a snow emergency it shall be unlawful for anyone to park a motor vehicle within the public right of way along the following:

	i.	South side of Crescent Avenue, T-405;	
	ii.	North side of Belmar Avenue, T-407;	
	iii.	East side of Sunset Drive, T-450;	
	iv.	West side of Pleasant Drive, T-425;	
	٧.	East side of Fairview Drive, T-448, between University Avenue	
		and Belmar Avenue;	
	vi.	West side of Fairview Drive, T-448, between Belmar Avenue and	
Crescent Drive;		Crescent Drive;	
	vii.	East side of Burgess Avenue, T-456;	
	viii.	West side of Gregory Avenue, T-458;	
	ix.	ix. North side of Sheri Lane, T-401;	
	х.	West side of Hillside Drive, T-504;	
	xi.	xi. North side and outside of Horizon Drive, T-505;	
	xii.	Both sides of Quarry Road, T-484;	
	xiii.	Both sides of Grayson View Court, T-517.	

SECTION TWO: Efective Date

This ordinance shall become effective five days after adoption.
