

ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - 07

**AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 96-1, PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS,  
PROHIBITING PARKING WITHIN FIFTEEN FEET OF DRIVE  
ENTRANCES, ESTABLISHING FINES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by Penn Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Article III, Section 3, of Township Ordinance No. 96-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

*"Article III*

*Traffic Regulations*

.....

*Section 3. Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations.*

*(a) Parking is prohibited within the public right-of-way along the following streets or portions of streets:*

<i>Street</i>	<i>Side</i>	<i>Between</i>
<i>1. Woodlynn Drive (T-512)</i>	<i>North</i>	<i>Intersection with 18th Street and intersection with Calvett Place</i>

*(b) Parking is prohibited within 15 feet of a public or private driveway entrance.*

*(c) Any person who violates any provision of this article shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$50.00 and costs.*

**SECTION TWO:** The remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 96-1, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION THREE: Effective Date**


This ordinance shall become effective five days after adoption.
