

**TOWNSHIP OF PENN
SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN,
SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE
FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES: (1) THE USE OF TOBACCO
PRODUCTS BY ALL INDIVIDUALS UPON TOWNSHIP
PROPERTY AT EAST SNYDER PARK; (2) THE
CONSUMPTION AND USE OF ALCOHOL OR
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY ALL INDIVIDUALS UPON
TOWNSHIP PROPERTY AT EAST SNYDER PARK.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, Snyder County,
Pennsylvania, hereby ENACTS AND ORDAINS as follows:

1. Prohibition of Tobacco Products.

It shall be unlawful for any person to use tobacco, in any form, upon the property of the Township of Penn, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, at the East Snyder Park facilities.

2. Prohibition of Alcohol or Alcoholic Beverages.

It shall be unlawful for any person to utilize or consume any alcohol, or alcoholic beverages located at the East Snyder Park facilities of the Township of Penn, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, or to maintain such alcohol or alcoholic beverages in an open container while utilizing any of the facilities of the Township of Penn located at the East Snyder Park facilities.

3. Penalty.

A violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a summary offense, and any person who violates this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars. This penalty shall be in addition to any other penalties or violations which may occur as a result of the conduct of any individual.


4. Definitions.

(a) Tobacco. A lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or other lighted smoking product and smokeless tobacco in any form.

(b) Alcohol or Alcoholic Beverage. Any product containing an alcoholic content of 0.05% or higher, whether in its original container, or in any other receptacle, and whether opened or unopened.
