ORDINANCE NO. 2011-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, SNYDER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING HUNTING ON ALL PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, hereby
ENACTS AND ORDAINS as follows:

1. Prohibition of Hunting.

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt upon any property owned by the Township of
Penn, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.

2. Penalty.

A violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a summary offense, and any person who
violates this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars. This
penalty shall be in addition to any other penalties or violations which may occur as a result of the
conduct of any individual.
