ORDINANCE NO.2012- 01

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, SNYDER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO
AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL RECYCLING SITE AGREEMENT WITH
THE COUNTY OF SNYDER AND SNYDER COUNTY SOLID WASTE
MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY.**

Whereas, Snyder County is the recipient of a grant in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty-six Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-five (\$326,975.000) Dollars from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for the construction of recycling drop off centers and implementation of recycling programs throughout Snyder County, Pennsylvania; and

Whereas, Penn Township, by and through its governing body, decided to host one of the recycling drop off centers being proposed by the County on its land; and

Whereas, the Township and the County mutually selected a specific site on the Township's land designated on Snyder County Tax Map 03, at Parcel 163, and more particularly described in Snyder County Record Book 575, at Page 234 ("Recycling Drop Off Site") which site shall be specifically demarcated on this land by the Township and shall not in any way interfere with the Township's use and enjoyment of the remainder of said land; and

Whereas, Snyder County Solid Waste Management Authority by ordinances is authorized to manage any and all solid waste generated in Snyder County, Pennsylvania, and in such capacity is supervising the recycling grant from DEP to the County; and

Whereas, the County, the Township, and Snyder County Solid Waste Management Authority desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Recycling Site Agreement setting forth their respective responsibilities for the recycling site, the term of the agreement, sharing the construction, operation


and other expenses for the recycling drop off site, applying for and applying the funds from any performance grants from DEP for the operation of the recycling drop off site, and disposing of the recyclable drop off at the recycling drop off center.

Therefore, the Township of Penn ORDAINS and ENACTS the following:

1. The Township of Penn is authorized to enter into an appropriate Intergovernmental Recycling Site Agreement with Snyder County and the Snyder County Solid Waste Management Authority.
