SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, SNYDER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD
#454, A/K/A OLD 11 & 15 ROAD, BEGINNING AT THE
INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH MARKET STREET FOR A DISTANCE
OF 0.07 MILES TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH TOWNSHIP ROAD
#389, A/K/A BAKE OVEN HILL ROAD.

WHEREAS, Township Road No. 454 a/k/a Old 11 & 15 Road, is a public road located within the Township of Penn, Snyder County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Penn have determined that a portion of Township Road No. 454 a/k/a Old 11 & 15 Road, beginning at its intersection with South Market Street for a distance of 0.07 miles to its intersection with Bake Oven Hill Road is not necessary for public convenience, and that the continued maintenance of the same is burdensome and unnecessary. A true and correct copy of a map depicting the portion of the road in question is attached hereto, made a part hereof and designated as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township, and in regular meeting duly assembled, it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by and with the authority of the same, that the portion of Township Road No. 454 a/k/a Old 11 & 15 Road beginning at its intersection with South Market Street for a distance of 0.07 miles to its intersection with Bake Oven Hill Road, as it appears on Exhibit "A", is hereby vacated with respect to any interest therein of the Township of Penn as a roadway, street, alley, or other public highway.
