The Penn Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting on Monday, October 17, 2011 at the Municipal Building, 228 Clifford Road, Selinsgrove, Snyder County, Pennsylvania. Chairman William Moyer called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Supervisors present: William Moyer, Brian Wentzel. Supervisors Absent: Fred Ulrich. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the September 27, 2011 meeting were approved as presented upon motion by Brian Wentzel, seconded by Bill Moyer, and approved.

PUBLIC COMMENT

PERSONS PRESENT TO BE HEARD

Bill Siegel and Glenda Ruch, Seda-Cog, was present to inform the Board that with the 2010 Census figures, Penn Township is now an Entitlement Community and qualifies for Community Development Block Grants(CDBG). This is a federally funded program created to benefit low to moderate income residents. A lengthy discussion ensued about possible qualifying areas and projects. Mr. Siegel also explained that Penn Township would need an 'agent' to administer the monies, which could be the Township, a consultant, or Snyder County. Applications must be submitted in March or April 2012. Mr. Siegel also explained that Seda-Cog will be available for assistance.
