

Penn Township Supervisor Meeting

February 4, 2026

Chairman Isaac Ramer Jr. called the 2.4.2026 Supervisor Meeting to order at 6:02 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present included: Supervisors: Isaac Ramer Jr., Mark Strawser, Jon Payne, Solicitor Jim Bathgate and Township Manager Julie Hartley

Public Present: Bill Kline, Paul Long, Chad Brandt, Chris Fetter, Daniel Chase, Adam Kerstetter, Jason Kaufman, Shellie McCurdy and Bruce Teats

Minutes – On motion by Mark Strawser, seconded by Jon Payne and Board acclamation to approve the January 21, 2026 supervisor's meeting minutes.

Persons Present to be Heard:

Shellie McCurdy, REC – Shellie shared that there were nine hundred and fifty check-ins for the month of January and 55.9 for the daily average attendance. Two hundred and seventy-four are registered with fifteen new kids during January. The REC will offer babysitting on Valentine's Day and Big Brothers and Big Sisters will be hosting a movie night.

New Business:

Letter to Supervisors regarding Penn DOT Multimodal Grant – The Board reviewed the letter notifying them that a Penn DOT Multimodal Grant was being applied for by the township manager. **On motion by Mark Strawser, seconded by Isaac Ramer Jr., and Board acclamation to accept the letter and allow the grant submission for the Penn DOT Multimodal Grant.**

Old Business:

New Dump Truck and Upfit to Replace 2005 Freightliner, \$215,199.48 – The Board reviewed the quote for the new dump truck and upfit. **On motion by Mark Strawser, seconded by Isaac Ramer Jr and Board acclamation to purchase the new dump truck and upfit in the amount of \$215,199.48.**

Persons Present to be Heard:

Jason Kaufman, DH&L Fire (via phone) – Jason shared that there were thirty-one incidents in the township for January which included one shed fire on Sassafras Street. They have also been shoveling out fire hydrants. The annual gun raffle will be in May.

- Adam Kerstetter, Roadmaster, Report Provided – Isaac asked about the big snow and Adam noted that the one plow's cylinders blew apart, some windshield wipers and a windshield wiper needed replaced. Each plow cylinder is over \$400. One mailbox was reported damaged.

- James Bathgate, Township Solicitor – Jim noted that at the February 18th meeting there will be a zoning amendment hearing regarding Data Centers. He also shared that he has drafted an ordinance for prohibiting parking on Old 11&15 which would have penalties enforced by the vehicle code. The ordinance would be adopted and then signs would be placed. Jim asked if April 1st would be when the Board would like to consider adopting the ordinance. **On motion by Jon Payne, seconded by Mark Strawser and Board acclamation to advertise the Old 11&15 Parking Ordinance for potential adoption on April 1, 2026.**

Public Comment:

Bruce Teats – Bruce shared that at the next township meeting that he will be bringing in sample ordinances from other townships that allow ATV and UTV vehicles on township roads. Troy Withers from DCNR was asked to be at the next meeting also. If an ordinance allowing this was passed special signs would have to be placed on the designated roads. Stickers could be sold by the township to generate revenue. Bruce explained that DCNR tags require that your ATV be licensed and insured and the operator must have a valid driver's license. Jim noted that it could open up the township to some liability.
