ORDINANCE NO.: 2026-04

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-05, RELATING TO PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF FIREWORKS IN THE TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OF PERMITS FOR SUPERVISED PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF FIREWORKS, PRESCRIBING SAFEGUARDS CONCERNING THE SAME, PROHIBITING PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF FIREWORKS AND THE POSSESSION, SALE, USE AND DISTRIBUTION THEREOF FOR PURPOSES OTHER THAN PUBLIC DISPLAYS WITHOUT OBTAINING A PERMIT THEREFORE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township as follows:

SECTION I. The Board of Supervisors hereby repeals Ordinance No. 2007-5, in its entirety.

SECTION II. All other Ordinances and Resolutions or part thereof as are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced on the earliest permitted date by the Second Class Township Code.
