

Penn Township Supervisor Meeting

March 18, 2026

Chairman Isaac Ramer Jr. called the 3.18.2026 Supervisor Meeting to order at 6:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present included: Supervisors: Isaac Ramer Jr., Mark Strawser and Jon Payne (arrived at 6:17 pm), and Township Manager Julie Hartley

Public Present: Bill Kline, Paul Long, Adam Kerstetter, Chad Brandt, Bruce Teats Jr., Chris Fetter, Gina Kuhns-Robatin, Elisha Jones, Blair Dunkle, Alyssa Shannon, Allison Norman and Brian Hipple.

Minutes – **On motion by Mark Strawser, seconded by Isaac Ramer Jr., with Isaac Ramer Jr. abstaining from the vote to approve the March 4, 2026 supervisor's meeting minutes.**

Persons Present to be Heard:

Gina Kuhns-Robatin – Gina presented to the Board that the Constables of the area would like to hold an Easter Egg hunt at the East Snyder Park on Saturday, March 28th. They would also like to utilize Pavilion #1. She continued by noting that the hunt would be for children up to age ten and is open to the public. The Roadmaster asked that field four be avoided because of ongoing construction. After discussion the following motion was made: **On motion by Mark Strawser, seconded by Isaac Ramer Jr., and Board acclamation to allow the egg hunt on March 28th if a certificate of insurance naming the township as additional insured is submitted.**

New Business:

Award Seal Coating Bids – The following bids were received for the sealcoating of Air Tower Road: Midland Asphalt in the amount of \$50,573.46 and Russell Standard in the amount of \$54,578.82. **On motion by Mark Strawser, seconded by Isaac Ramer Jr., and Board acclamation to award the sealcoating bid to Midland Asphalt in the amount of \$50,573.46 provided they supply the township with the payment and performance bonds, submit a certificate of insurance with the township named as additional insured, signature on the contract documents and the Solicitor reviews and approves the submissions.**

Award Paving Bids – The following bids were received for the paving of sections of Miller Farm Road, Foxboro Road and Fairview Drive: Gutelius, Inc. in the amount of \$198,332.00; Rite Way Sealing & Paving in the amount of \$210,735.84; New Enterprise Stone in the amount of \$224,819.00; Big Rock Paving in the amount of \$232,247.00; and HRI, Inc. in the amount of \$335,756.00. **On motion by Isaac Ramer Jr., seconded by Mark Strawser, and Board acclamation to award the paving bid to Gutelius, Inc. in the amount of \$198,332.00 provided they supply the township with the payment and performance bonds, submit a certificate of insurance with the township named as additional insured, signature on the contract documents and the Solicitor reviews and approves the submissions.**

Public Comment:

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Brian Hipple, DH&L Ambulance – Brian gave the February ambulance report noting that there were one hundred and seventy-one calls with sixty-one in Penn Township and one call missed. He said they are getting ready to send out next year's ambulance subscriptions and the price will remain the same as last year. They purchased two new ambulances and are in the process of getting them ready for service. They are also working with the Susquehanna University Emergency Management Club to get an ambulance on campus staffed by the students. The SU ambulance would be mainly for campus calls and standbys but would also be a community resource. All of the students involved are full members of DH&L Ambulance.
